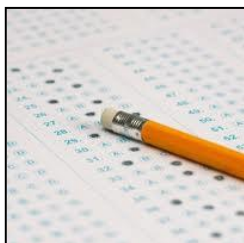
Fast Facts – Fiscal Year 2011 – 2012

Since 1937, approximately 58,500 Certificates of Qualification have been issued

- 65 designated trades
- 5653 active apprentices
- Over 2626 employers participated in the Apprenticeship Program



- 964 Certificates of Qualification issued
- 817 Interprovincial Red Seals issued
- 1865 Certificates of Qualification renewed in compulsory certified trades
- 1387 new apprentices registered
- 75 registered as a youth apprentice (19 years of age or younger)
- Essential skills assessment is included as part of apprenticeship registration process
- Practical training provided on-the-job (85%), technical training (15%)
- 2417 apprentices received technical training
- 815 sections of in-class training offered from April 1, 2011 to March 31, 2012
- Training in most programs available in-class or via the internet
- 277 applications for certification received from trade qualifiers
- 277 trade qualifier applications processed and approved
- 1555 examinations administered



- 1296 certification examinations written – 69% pass rate
- Apprentices wrote 891 certification examinations – 72% pass rate
- Trade qualifiers wrote 405 certification examinations – 58% pass rate
- 1201 Interprovincial examinations administered – 68% pass rate
- Apprentices wrote 833 Interprovincial examinations – 72% pass rate
- Trade qualifiers wrote 271 Interprovincial examinations – 59% pass rate
- 224 progress examinations written – 76% pass rate
- Apprentices wrote 217 progress examinations with a pass rate of 76%
- Non-apprentices wrote 7 progress examinations with a pass rate of 57%
