Fast Facts – Fiscal Year 2012 – 2013

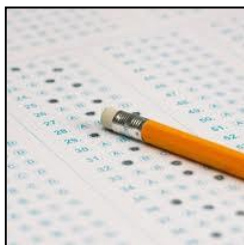
- 66 designated trades
- 5916 active apprentices
- The average age of new apprentices is 28.3 years
- Over 2716 employers participated in the Apprenticeship Program



- 976 Certificates of Qualification issued
- 833 Interprovincial Red Seals issued
- 2434 Certificates of Qualification renewed in compulsory certified trades
- 1586 new apprentices registered
- 89 registered as a youth apprentice (19 years of age or younger)
- 2260 apprentices received technical training
- 1098 sections of in-class training offered from April 1, 2012 to March 31, 2013
- 266 applications for certification received from trade qualifiers
- 249 trade qualifier applications processed and approved



- 1576 examinations administered



- 1287 certification examinations written – 71% pass rate
- Apprentices wrote 831 certification examinations – 74% pass rate
- Trade qualifiers wrote 456 certification examinations – 66% pass rate
- 1166 Interprovincial examinations administered – 71% pass rate
- Apprentices wrote 750 Interprovincial examinations – 75% pass rate
- Trade qualifiers wrote 334 Interprovincial examinations – 64% pass rate
- 240 progress examinations written – 73% pass rate
- 49 practical examinations written – 76% pass rate
- Apprentices wrote 234 progress examinations with a pass rate of 74%
- Non-apprentices wrote 6 progress examinations with a pass rate of 50%
