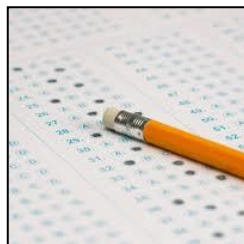
Fast Facts – Fiscal Year 2013 – 2014

- 66 designated trades
- 6023 active apprentices
- The average age of new apprentices is 28.8 years
- As of 31 March 2014, over 1749 employers with active apprentices participated in the Apprenticeship Program



- 932 Certificates of Qualification issued
- 833 Interprovincial Red Seals issued
- 2300 Certificates of Qualification renewed in compulsory certified trades
- 1533 new apprentices registered
- 83 registered as a youth apprentice (19 years of age or younger)
- 2188 apprentices received technical training (In-class)
- 232 applications for certification received from trade qualifiers
- 227 trade qualifier applications processed and approved

- 2021 examinations administered



- 1725 certification examinations written – 78% pass rate
- Apprentices wrote 1240 certification examinations – 86% pass rate
- Trade qualifiers wrote 348 certification examinations – 59% pass rate
- 1198 Interprovincial examinations administered – 70% pass rate
- Apprentices wrote 746 Interprovincial examinations – 77% pass rate
- Trade qualifiers wrote 335 Interprovincial examinations – 58% pass rate
- 277 progress examinations written – 75% pass rate
- Apprentices wrote 242 progress examinations with a pass rate of 81%
- Non-apprentices wrote 35 progress examinations with a pass rate of 46%
- 19 practical examinations written – 89% pass rate
