

ENROLMENT IN ONLINE APPRENTICESHIP COURSES TEMPORARILY UNAVAILABLE

From August 7, 2017 until September 5, 2017, enrolment in all ONLINE apprenticeship courses will be unavailable.

From August 7, 2017 until October 23, 2017, enrolment in ONLINE Level 1 Construction Electrician and Industrial Electrician courses will be unavailable. This is to enable our training provider, Nova Scotia Community College (NSCC), to capture changes due to Atlantic Apprenticeship Harmonization in their new learning management system.

We are improving how we deliver apprenticeship technical training online. From August 7 – September 5, 2017, all online courses are being converted to a new learning management system. This system, Desire2Learn, will provide an improved learning experience for apprentices.

During this transition, enrolment in all online courses will be unavailable to ensure that the new system is tested and working properly.

Apprentices who are currently enrolled and actively completing an online course will be able to continue their studies without disruption. Your next course will be managed from the new system. NSCC, who delivers the online training on behalf of the Nova Scotia Apprenticeship Agency (NSAA), will communicate relevant information directly with you and post a message on your course login page, as well.

Apprentices who are registered to take online courses but have NOT started will have access to orientation materials on the new system. Once on the new system, NSCC will provide you with navigation support and a dedicated Online Student Support Specialist who you can reach by email Apprenticeship@nscc.ca or direct phone line (toll free) 1-877-491-6774.

While we appreciate that a brief suspension of registration for online courses may cause some inconveniences for some apprentices, please be assured that NSAA and our training provider, NSCC, are committed to delivering a high quality online learning experience for all apprentices.
